# Proposed Amendment of the Rules governing the OTC registration platform (PCE) Under Article 17 of Annex A to Decision 111/06 of the AEEG (Autorità per l'energia elettrica e il gas) and following amendments and integrations

Request for transactions' registration and validation of a Transaction registration confirmation. 1. Foreword

With a resolution dated February 7, 2007 the AEEG (Direzione Mercati - Autorità per l'energia

elettrica e il gas) positively assessed the Rules of OTC registration platform (PCE), under article 7 of

Annex A to Decision 111/06 of the AEES (Autorità per l'energia elettrica e il gas), as subsequently

amended and integrated with AEEG Resolution of April 5th, 2007 and AEEG 91/2012/I/COM

Judgment of March 15, 2012 (hereafter: Rules).

Article 3, paragraph 3.5 of the Regulation provides that "GME may propose amendments to

these Rules and notify them to interested parties by publishing them on its website or by other

suitable means, allowing at least fifteen days for submission of comments, if any. Taking into

account the comments received, GME shall then submit the proposed amendments (and the reasons

therefor) to AEEG for approval.

With a view to simplify the means of registration and confirmation of transactions within

PCE, GME has prepared this consultation document on proposed amendments of the Rules, with a

view to gathering comments and food for thought from interested parties.

2. Content of the proposal

The proposed amendment of the Rules governing the OTC registration platform (PCE) aims at

simplifying the means of registration of transactions on the abovestated platform, also in light of

requests being made by some Participants, in this regard as well as some category associations.

In particular, Participants have expressed the need for an easier means of registration and

confirmation of transactions compared to the existing one; to be more specific, to make the use of

the matching code when submitting a request "optional" and not "compulsory".

In submitting such a request, Participants highlighted that the compulsory nature of the code to be

used does slow down the registration procedure of transactions on PCE.

In order to better represent the request for change submitted by the Participants, it is

worth recalling the current means of registration of transactions within PCE. As of today, the

Participant submitting the registration request of a transaction indicates, among other bits of

information and the Counterparty Participant of the transaction itself, the matching code

associated to the aforesaid request. For the registration to be successful the Counterparty must

enter the same matching code while confirming the registration request.

By meeting the Participants' request, the use of the matching code upon submission of a

request would no longer be compulsory. Therefore, the matching code entry would be compulsory

only for the Counterparty Participant, who confirms the registration solely when the Participant

requiring the registration has deliberately entered such a code.

Article 33: "Request for Registering Transactions"

Request for Registering Transactions

The text of Article 33, para 33.2, letter h), has been modified as follows:

### 33.2

Upon submitting a request for registering a transaction, the Participant shall specify at least the following data:

- a) type of transaction (sale/purchase);
- b) days of flow for which the transaction is to be registered;
- c) applicable periods for which the transaction is to be registered;
- d) quantity of electricity covered by the transaction, for each day of flow and each applicable period;
- e) electricity accounts for which the Participant has been authorised and on which, for each day of flow and applicable period, the transaction is to be registered;
- f) the counterparty Participant to the transaction;
- g) the time limit within which the counterparty Participant shall confirm the request for registration. Such time limit shall precede the first day of flow, referred to in para. b) above, by at least two
- h) the matching code of the request for registration

### New text

### 33.2

Upon submitting a request for registering a transaction, the Participant shall specify at least the following data:

- a) type of transaction (sale/purchase);
- b) days of flow for which the transaction is to be registered;
- c) applicable periods for which the transaction is to be registered;
- d) quantity of electricity covered by the transaction, for each day of flow and each applicable period;
- e) electricity accounts for which the Participant has been authorised and on which, for each day of flow and applicable period, the transaction is to be registered;
- f) the counterparty Participant to the transaction;
- g) the time limit within which the counterparty Participant shall confirm the request for registration. Such time limit shall precede the first day of flow, referred to in para. b) above, by at least two days:
- h) **possible** matching code of the request for registration

# Article 37: "Validation of Confirmation of Registration of a Transaction"

The text of Article 37, para 37.1, letter f) has been modified as follows:

- 37.1 If the counterparty Participant referred to in Article 33, para. 33.2 f) above confirms the transaction, then GME shall check whether:
- a) the Participant has not been suspended;
- b) the transaction to be confirmed corresponds to the type of request mentioned in

Article 33, para. 33.2 a) above; the days of flow correspond to those mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 b)

above;

d) the applicable periods correspond to those mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 c)

# New text

# (omissis)

- 37.1 If the counterparty Participant referred to in Article 33, para. 33.2 f) above confirms the transaction, then GME shall check whether:
- a) the Participant has not been suspended;
- b) the transaction to be confirmed corresponds to the type of request mentioned in

Article 33, para. 33.2 a) above; the days of flow correspond to those mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 b)

above;

d) the applicable periods correspond to those mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 c)

### above;

- e) in each applicable period, the total quantity of electricity covered by the transaction is the same as the one mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 d) above;
- f) the specified matching code is the same as the one mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 h) above;
- g) the confirmation has been submitted in accordance with the modalities stated in Article 33, para. 33.3 above;
- h) the counterparty Participant is entitled to register transactions on the specified electricity accounts.

above;

- e) in each applicable period, the total quantity of electricity covered by the transaction is the same as the one mentioned in Article 33, para. 33.2 d) above;
- f) the specified matching code is the same as **the code possibly** indicated according to the previous Article 33,

para. 33.2 h) above;

- g) the confirmation has been submitted in accordance with the modalities stated in Article 33, para. 33.3 above;
- h) the counterparty Participant is entitled to register transactions on the specified electricity accounts.
