1. Foreword

Article 26, Paragraph 26.2, of the Electricity Market Rules states that the unit prices specified in the offers/bids must be within the limits specified in the Technical Rules.

2. Limits to the prices of offers in the MPE

The unit prices shown in the offers submitted into the MGP and MI should be:

- Greater than 0 €/MWh and lower or equal to 3,000 €/MWh for the offers of purchase. The specification in such offers of a unit price equal to 0 €/MWh is equivalent to a non-specified price, so this gives the highest price priority to the offer;
- Greater than or equal to zero or lower than or equal to 3,000 €/MWh for the offers/bids.
