1. Foreword

Article 55 quinquies, paragraph 55 quinquies 1, of the Integrated Text of the Electricity Market Rules (hereinafter "ME Rules") provides that each Market Participant holding a zonal portfolio may request, during the nomination phase, the registration of hourly PN nominations for injection and withdrawal referring to the offer points belonging to such portfolio, according to the procedures defined in this article and in the Technical Rules.

Article 55 quinquies, paragraph 55 quinquies 2, of the ME Rules provides that registration requests can be submitted by:

- a) the compilation of specific forms available in the IT system of the PN;
- b) sending a file, through the IT system of the PN, in the format defined in the Technical Rules.

Article 55 quinquies, paragraph 55 quinquies 3, of the ME Rules provides that the request for registration of each hourly PN nomination must contain at least the following information, in addition to any other information indicated in the Technical Rules:

- a) the identification code of the offer point to which it refers;
- b) the flow day;
- c) the relevant period;
- d) the type of nomination (injection/withdrawal);
- e) the quantity of energy subject of the nomination.

2. Procedures for submitting requests for the registration of nominations

Market Participants wishing to submit a request for the registration of a nomination must:

- have a IT station which, through an *Internet* connection; allow authentication to the SIME¹ and signing with digital certificates;
- designate one or more users authorised to access the SIME ("users").

The sending, modification, revocation as well as any other action relating to requests for the registration of nominations can take place in two ways:

¹ SIME: The IT system of the Electricity Market. It is the IT system through which GME collects the purchase and sale and offers, defines the market results and makes preliminary information and outcomes available, collects requests for the registration of nominations and makes injection and withdrawal programs available.

- filling in of the appropriate forms (web form) available on the SIME;
- submission (*Uploading*) of a file with the structure specified in the document "XML implementation guide for market participant", published on GME's website (<u>www.mercatoelettrico.org</u>).

It is understood that each participant can send requests for the registration of nominations and can also modify or rectify the provisional hourly nominations, only within the deadlines set for implementation of the nomination phase.

Failure by the Market Participant to submit a request for registration of a nomination for a certain relevant period and for a specific offer point is considered equivalent to the submission of a nomination equal to "0" for the corresponding registered period and of the corresponding offer point.
